

The North-West University is offering three post-Doctoral positions for research in the School of Ancient Languages and Text Studies and the Research Focus Area Ancient Texts: Text, Context, and Reception. It is envisaged that a research fellow will be appointed in three of the following fields: Classics, Greek, Latin or Semitic Languages.

Appointment entails a grant of ZAR 180 000 p.a. and a relocation fee (up to ZAR 20 000), as well as a budget for running costs of up to ZAR 20 000 p.a. The fellowship may be renewed for up to three years, based on measurable research outputs.

Applicants will hold a PhD in Classics, Greek, Latin or Semitic Languages and be committed to publish in journal article format. Applications from any field from the Ancient World are welcome, but preference may be given to those that will contribute to projects already established in the school.

Deadline for applications: 15 December 2017.
